This second section covers fifty three (53) patterns. With these two sections an attempt has been made to identify as many Carnival (Iridized) candlesticks as possible. In several cases two or more glass companies made very similar candlesticks and the difference is the dimensions, colors made, or the size of the candle cup.

This section covers the Brocaded candlesticks. A special thanks to Frank and Shirley Randall, Richland, Oregon and Norine Andreatta, Columbiana, Ohio, for supplying much of the necessary information and photographs of the Brocaded candlesticks.

Refer to the "Makers Identification" information, at the end of the first section. It helps identify the makers of the "Colonial" (Florentine), Short "Trumpet," tall "Trumpet," and "Spindle" candlesticks.

We wish to thank John Madeley and Dave Shetlar, authors of the American Iridescent Stretch Glass Identification & Value Guide for permission to use the Makers Identification sketches and other information from their book. This is a very good reference book for Carnival Glass collectors.
