Tulip and Cane

This is Year 2007 addition to the HOACGA Notebook. It is an attempt to present information on Cordial, Whiskey, & Wine Sets and Goblets and the associated pieces where there are no known decanters to make a set. This information covers both U.S. and Non U.S. patterns. A photograph was not available for some pieces, only the description is presented. The information contained in this section would not have been possible if it were not for members who were willing to send photographs and information about the pieces in their collection. Your help is greatly appreciated.

The idea for this section started when John & Loretta Nielsen presented an Educational program at the 2006 ICGA convention in Cedar Rapids, IA. Several collectors supplied pieces for the program. It was obvious there were many different pieces available but this information had not been assembled in any one place.

There is not any clear definition as to the exact identity of whether it is a Champagne, Claret, Cordial, Wine or Goblet. As a general rule they are identified by the amount of liquid they hold, a Goblet holds 8 ounces, a Claret holds 4 ounces, a Wine holds 2 ounces and a Cordial holds 1 ounce or less (for reference one cup equals 8 ounces).

Champagne

Color: Marigold (Rare)
Note: This shape is rare. It is 5½" tall with a 5" top diameter.

Claret

2. **Pattern:** Tulip & Cane
Maker: Imperial
Color: Marigold
Note: The claret is about twice the size of the wines. They are listed as holding 4 ounces of liquids. Claret is 6½" tall, with a 3¼" base and a 3½" top opening. See HOACGA Educational Book I, page 144 for comparison to goblet, wine, and cordial.

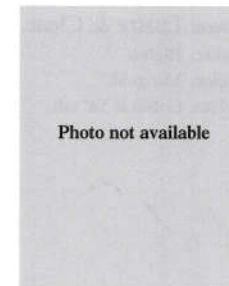

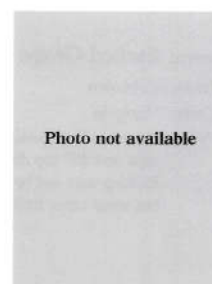

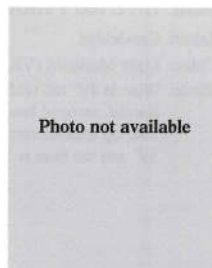

Note: Also known as Imperial #9 pattern. This was reproduced by Imperial in blue. It is also referred to as "Kite & Panel." The height is 6 1/4", the top is 3 1/4", and the base is 3 1/4".

84. Pattern: Arrowhead & Oval

Color: Marigold (R)
Note: No decanter known. The Higbee reference book shows this piece was made in two shapes, straight sides and one that was belled out. Wine is 3 1/4" tall, with a base diameter of 2 1/4" & a 2 1/4" top opening. It has an impressed star underneath the base.

Maker: Unknown

Color: Marigold

Note: Wine is 3½" tall with a plain base. It has an enameled daisy with yellow center and dots. The top measurement is 1½" and the base is 1½".

90. Pattern: Etched Grape

Maker: Unknown

Color: Marigold

Note: Wine is 4" tall, with a 2½" base and 2½" top diameter. Etching may not be grapes but some other fruit.

91. Pattern: Flute

Maker: Imperial

Color: Marigold

Note: Wine is 3½" tall with 8 flutes on cup that carry through the stem and has a rayed base. This pattern is similar to "Chesterfield" except for the rayed pattern on the underside of the base. This may not be an Imperial pattern.

Note: No sets known in Carnival Glass. Wine is 4" tall with a base diameter of 1½" and top diameter of 2½".

Note: Wine is 4½" tall with a starred, serrated base edge. The top measurement is 3½" and the base is 2½".

Note: This wine is considered very rare. Wine is 4½" tall with a base and top diameter of 2½".

Note: This wine can be found in 5 different heights, 3½", 3¾", 3¾", 4", and 4½". The base and top diameter will vary according to the heights. The shorter ones may also be referred to as cordials. This pattern is known with a Green Flash iridescence.

Note: This wine comes in three different heights, 4¾", 4½", 5¼", with plain base.

Note: Note the ring around the top and also at the bottom of the bowl part. This is different than the Variant which does not have these rings. Wines are 5½" tall, base diameter is 2½", with a top opening of 2½".
