OSCAR THE LION BY WILMA THURSTON


This is eighth in a series of glass made in the 1980's.

Oscar the Lion was made by Mosser Glass Company of Cambridge, Ohio for Summit Art Glass Company. The first issue was June 1981.

Oscar is $4\frac{1}{2}$ " long and $2\frac{1}{2}$ " high. There were two 12 Lion issues and then the mold was sawed into pieces and each active dealer received a section of the mold. Destroying the mold would insure it would never be made again and insure the future value of the Lion.

Island Mold of Wheeling, West Virginia was the mold maker.
