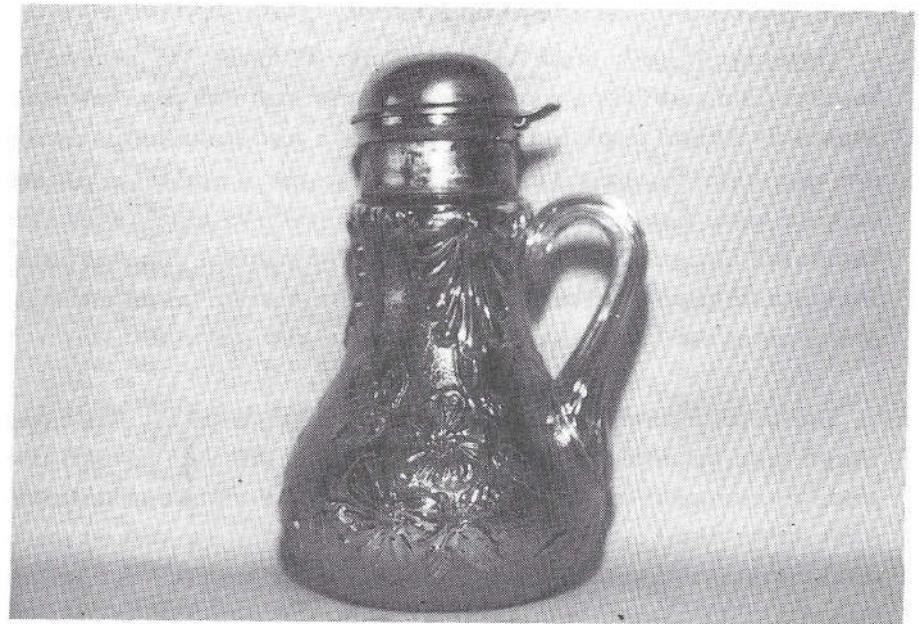
EDUCATIONAL TUMBLER SERIES

THE SINGLE ROSE TUMBLER

This pretty tumbler is in marigold over milk glass. It is four inches high and contains a 32 point rayed figure pressed into the underside of the base. The top one inch of the tumbler is plain and contains no stippling. Just below this plain area is a narrow band containing the old egg and dart motif. Included in this band and extending downward are four large acanthus leaves in high relief that are evenly spaced around the tumbler. Another band containing the egg and dart motif, in high relief is used around the bottom of the base. The acanthus leaves are not used in the bottom band. The area between these two bands contains four sprays of rose foilage with a flower. Each of the flowers is a single one with five petals and many central stamens. The background in this area is stippled. The interior of the tumbler is opaque white and is not iridized.



The Single Rose pattern can be found in Kamm book #3 on page 86. It is illustrated in a creamer. The pattern is also shown in "The Collector's Encyclopedia of Pattern Glass" by Mollie McCain on page 255 - plate #122. This pattern was made by the Westmoreland Glass Company of Pennsylvania.

The featured Single Rose tumbler is the only one that we have ever seen in carnival glass. In the above photo, we show the Wild Rose syrup in marigold. We want you to notice the similarity of the two patterns. Both use the acanthus leaves, both have the stippled background and both feature the rose spray motif. In the Wild Rose syrup design two of the flowers are used instead of the one found in the Single Rose pattern. Since we know that the Single Rose pattern is Westmoreland, the great resemblance of the two patterns makes us believe that the Wild Rose Syrup was also made by Westmoreland.

ON THE AUCTION TRAIL WITH CHUCK

November 1, 1997: Seeck Auction, Ontario, California. Jim promised the Southern California folks a good auction not associated with any convention. Supposedly the area people had been deprived of a good carnival glass auction long enough, and the time and location cried out for one. I went out to visit and enjoy the whole thing and was not disappointed. It was 90 degrees when I left Ontario and 32 degrees and snowing when I got to Minneapolis. I changed planes and we left the gate on time, but the plane sat in line an hour and five minutes to get de-iced and on our way.

Did the auction live up to the expectations? The jury is still out. The crowd was adequate, but it seemed like many were from some distance. We could have used a few more of the locals (100 mile radius). I guess it will take a little time to warm up the West Coast buyers - at times the sale lacked the Midwest spark. Hindsight probably says the 5½ hours, including the short break, it took to sell the glass was a bit too long.

The glass was super clean and in general had above average iridescence. I was interested in a couple of items, but they were both in the lower end that sold very well and I didn't get them as they exceeded my pricing. The high end of the glass also sold well. The \$200 to about \$750 or mid-range category was the problem area. It was a challenge and a struggle all day long on these items. In my opinion, it was a missed opportunity for many collectors to add good pieces to their collections at affordable prices. In the end, there were many happy buyers, and one of the owners that was present was happy with the results, and that is what really matters.

November 8, 1997: Seeck Auction, Wentzville, Missouri. I had seen this collection and there was something in it I wanted, so it was off to Wentzville. I have known Mike and Lucy Hood for several years, and when Marge was diagnosed with cancer, Lucy was particularly kind and helpful.

There was some good glass for everyone in this sale. I like the amethyst Birmingham Age Herald ruffled bowl (\$2000), the ice green Rose Show plate (\$3300), the amethyst Millersburg Court House IC shaped bowl (\$800), the peach opal Holly ruffled bowl (\$2150) and the nice purple Town Pump at \$900.

This was the first time I had a chance to buy a complete white Wreathed Cherry table set with red painted cherries, and it went home with me. I thought the red cherries made this set a little different. It now is a companion to my white set with gold cherries.

This auction ended a long and busy carnival auction year for me. I enjoyed every minute of it and am looking forward to 1998.

FENTON'S #233 LUMINA SHADE

Bill Heacock's book, *Fenton Glass, The First 25 Years* shows on page 109 an advertisement featuring an assortment of iridescent glass lamp shades made in 1914. The ad pictures four patterns known by collectors today as Pillar & Drape (Fenton's #232), Dragon's Tongue (#230), Leaf Tiers (#231) and what we are going to call Colonial (#233).

These shades were available in three iridescent finishes, gold (marigold), pearl (white) and lumina (marigold over milk glass). Marigold over milk glass (MMG) is how they are being reported in the Mordini auction reports and to keep things uncomplicated we will use his term. Although some collectors might feel they are marigold over moonstone.

We feel that Helen Greguire in her "Carnival in Lights" book erroneously calls these shades peach opal. Regardless of whether they are Fenton's Lumina or Northwood's Luna glass, both companies used an iridescence spray over a white opaque base glass. The Northwood's shades base glass, such as their Pillar & Drape, is more translucent compared to Fenton's shades.

Marion Hartung's book six states: "During the period of 1900-1915, almost every glass company producing tableware made at least one pattern carrying some version of a plain, panelled pattern, and most of these were either numbered, or named "Colonial", or a variant thereof." So we will call these lamp shades "Colonial" in this article for lack of a better name.

This marigold lumina Colonial shade has that metallic luster very nearly reminiscent of art glass. We would have to describe it as similar to Steuben's Gold Aurene. Iridized inside and out the color is a rich pumpkin gradually fading to a lighter colored skirt, with the white opaque peeking through. A very pretty shade to light up your life till you find that rare "whatever" you think you have to have.

PICTORIAL PATTERN PARADE

SAILBOATS PLATE IN BLUE

Sailboats is a well known and very popular Fenton pattern. In addition to our featured little plate, this pattern can also be found in small bowls or saucers, compotes, goblets and wines. The saucers can be found in a good many colors, but the little plates are known only in marigold and blue. Since the saucers are known in green it is possible that a green plate might show up some day. This little plate is seldom seen in any color, but the blue is substantially more rare than the marigold.

The plates measure 6 to 6½ inches wide and carry the orange tree pattern on the back. In 1982, in his list of small plates, Don Moore stated that the marigold Sailboats plate would sell in the \$100.00 range and that a blue one had sold from a room at a recent auction for \$250.00. We have noticed quite a rise in the price of these little plates. We bought our first blue plate at an antique show in Louisiana

on our way to Florida in 1971 for \$65.00. We got our first marigold Sailboats plate in a small general auction at the Armory in Clay Center, Kansas in 1970 for \$11.00. It was the only piece of carnival there.

In checking into Mordini's auction prices during the 1990's, I noticed that a marigold Sailboats plate had sold for \$775.00 at the 9-30-1994 Sam Wolfe auction at Flint, Michigan. A blue plate had sold as high as \$1400.00 at the 3-18-95 Ed Naplecek Richfield, Ohio auction. I also know of a blue example that sold privately in 1993 for \$1500. I find that 5 blue Sailboats plates and 10 marigold examples sold at auction during those years.

This article on the little Sailboats plate is the 229th entry into our Pictorial Pattern Parade. Next month we will feature a Millersburg Rosalind compote in Blue. We would like to wish you all a very Merry Christmas! John & Lucile.

LET'S PUT A LID ON IT

If we stand back and take a look at the Carnival Glass "Want Ads", there never seems to be a shortage of collectors looking for lids to powder jars and glass stoppers for wine carafes. This especially holds true for the Imperial Grape wine carafe. The available supply of excess glass powder jar lids and stoppers is almost non-existent. I do offer a few solutions which could "revitalize" the appearance and value of the glassware pieces I just mentioned.

With respect to powder jars, I believe it is feasible to manufacture round lids out of wood such as Birds Eye Maple or Walnut using a wood lathe or possibly having lids stamped out of thin chrome plated metal in a large production run. Are there any entrepreneurial craftsman or capitalists out there amongst us? Wine Carafes needing stoppers is a little bit more challenging, but I endorse the idea of approaching one of the glass companies producing contemporary carnival and asking them to make wine stoppers in purple, marigold and green with their trade mark affixed and of a different glassware design from the original stoppers. This should be required so the new contemporary stoppers could be easily identified from the correct Carnival Glass stoppers.

If you every tried in earnest to find a decent powder jar lid or a glass bottle stopper you can understand what a time consuming and costly process this is. I'm hopeful that collector's will endorse this idea so we can "complete" glassware items easily and in an affordable manner while adhering to the policy of separating old glassware from new glassware. Most collectors would pay \$20 to \$25 just to put a lid on this particular collecting problem. As a side note, punch bowl bases unintentionally divorced from their punch bowl tops do make wonderful candlestick holders using 3 or 4 inch diameter candles. Very grand for the holidays! Seasons Greetings and happy glass hunting everyone.

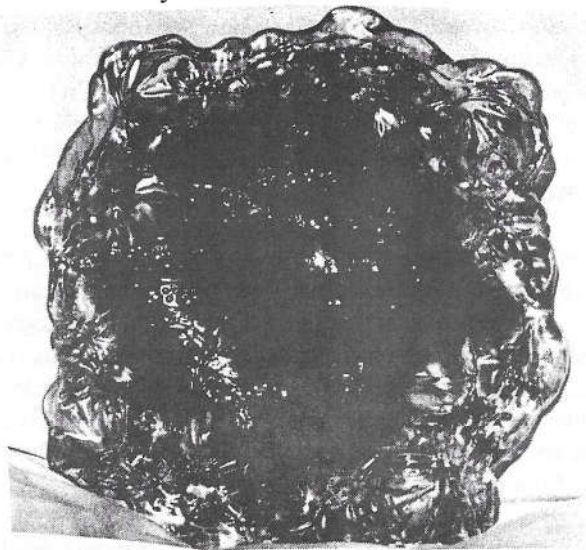

MARIGOLD ROSE/ GREEK KEY PLATE

"WOW"! There is still rare, rare glass to be found. We traveled 2,400 miles, in four days, to get this beautiful MARIGOLD ROSE/GREEK KEY plate.

The plate is 8½" across and 10" from corner to corner. On the front are three roses in each corner and ten rows of flowers 3/8 of an inch wide. On the back, the roses are indented like the Rose Show pieces. It has a domed round base with no collar. There are ten rows of flowers 3/8 of an inch wide and nine rows of Greek Key design 1/4 of an inch wide.

The lady that had this plate bought it in Florida two years ago. It was at an auction and she said there were only 20 other pieces of \$25 to \$30 pieces in the auction. She has had the plate two years in her china cabinet.

She called Don Kime during the convention, at home and asked him if he would be interested in buying the plate or would know of someone who might be interested. She just happened to get the Antique Trader and had seen there was a convention in Wichita, Kansas and somehow Don's name was on the ad. Don called me and said he was not interested and wanted to know if we were. I said "yes", so he gave me the lady's name and telephone number.

CONTEMPORARY HATPINS

The two buttons/hatpins illustrated on the left are examples of many designs being made today in the Czech Republic. These buttons/hatpins have blue iridescence with amethyst highlights, and come with cone shanks, which can be fitted with either a brass plate and loop as a button, or with a shaft as a hatpin. I have seen the hatpin sized ones being marketed at embellishment shows for less than ten dollars each.

The button/hatpin on the right is an Aurora design made in West Germany in the 1950's. The self shank is ground down and drilled to attach a hatpin shaft. The iridescence is a beautiful amethyst, and I believe this design is called "Two Flowers."

These and other contemporary designs have been showing up at auctions and carnival glass conventions in the past few years. These beautiful hatpins/buttons are very collectable, but should be priced accordingly as contemporary pieces.

- * A Hospitality time is provided by the club. This is a time of relaxation and visiting with other members.

It takes the support of all collectors and members to promote the hobby in order that its growth and expansion can continue.

In order to obtain our objective, the members must financially support the organization. The Heart of America Carnival Glass Association receives its financial support through the Annual Membership dues and the sale of the following.
